MV748, Malvern, running from point A, Ordnance Survey "OS" grid reference SO78644 48571, on Lower Howsell Road, in a south-easterly direction for 196 metres to point B, OS grid reference SO78815 48475, to a line running from point A, OS grid reference SO78644 48571, a point on Lower Howsell Road, in a south-south-westerly direction for 9 metres on the footway to point C, grid reference SO78642 48562, then continuing on the footway in a south-easterly turning easterly direction for 36 metres to point D, grid reference SO78673 48548, then continuing on the footway in a south-easterly direction for 41 metres to point E, grid reference SO78708 48525, then continuing on the footway in a north-easterly direction for 11 metres to point F, grid reference SO78716 48530, then continuing across the road and on the footway in a south-easterly direction for 59 metres to point G, grid reference SO78764 48494, then continuing on the footway in an east-southeasterly direction for 34 metres to point H, grid reference SO78792 48488, then continuing on the footway in a south-easterly direction for 25 metres to point B, grid reference SO78815 48475, as shown on the order map.
