Highways England notes that a specific site (land to the east of Old Road South) has been put forward in the Neighbourhood Plan for enabling additional housing development. This site is in addition to growth identified in the draft South Worcestershire Development Plan. The number of dwellings to come forward at the site is not specified although the site area is only 2.5 hectares and therefore it is not expected that it would accommodate a significant number of dwellings. Nevertheless, the traffic impact of this development on the SRN has not been tested and will need to be assessed in accordance with 'DfT Circular 02/2013 The Strategic Road Network and the delivery of sustainable development' which sets out our requirements for assessing the traffic implications of development. Highways England is satisfied that this requirement can be addressed as the planning application comes forward. The relevant developer is encouraged to engage in pre-application discussions with Highways England.
