Analysis of provision

- 27.1 There are a number of fitness facilities in Malvern Hills District, accessible by the majority of the population.
- 27.2 The main facility is located at the Splash Leisure Centre and a membership package for the fitness suite is available, either as a single membership or part of a wider leisure membership. Consultation suggests that the facility is well used at peak times and there is no waiting list. A number of qualified staff delivers specialised fitness sessions, available at extra cost.
- 27.3 A new fitness suite facility is currently being installed at Dyson Perrins High School. There are plans to commission an external leisure provider to operate the new facility on a dual-use agreement. It is anticipated that this facility will meet current demand in Malvern Link for a fitness facility.

Fitness summary

Current provision

- There are five facilities provided 154 fitness stations in Malvern Hills District.

Future provision

- The new facility at Dyson Perrins will meet any additional need in the District.

Other issues

- Good quality, accessible provision is available throughout the District. The new facility at Dyson Perrins High School is available to the community.



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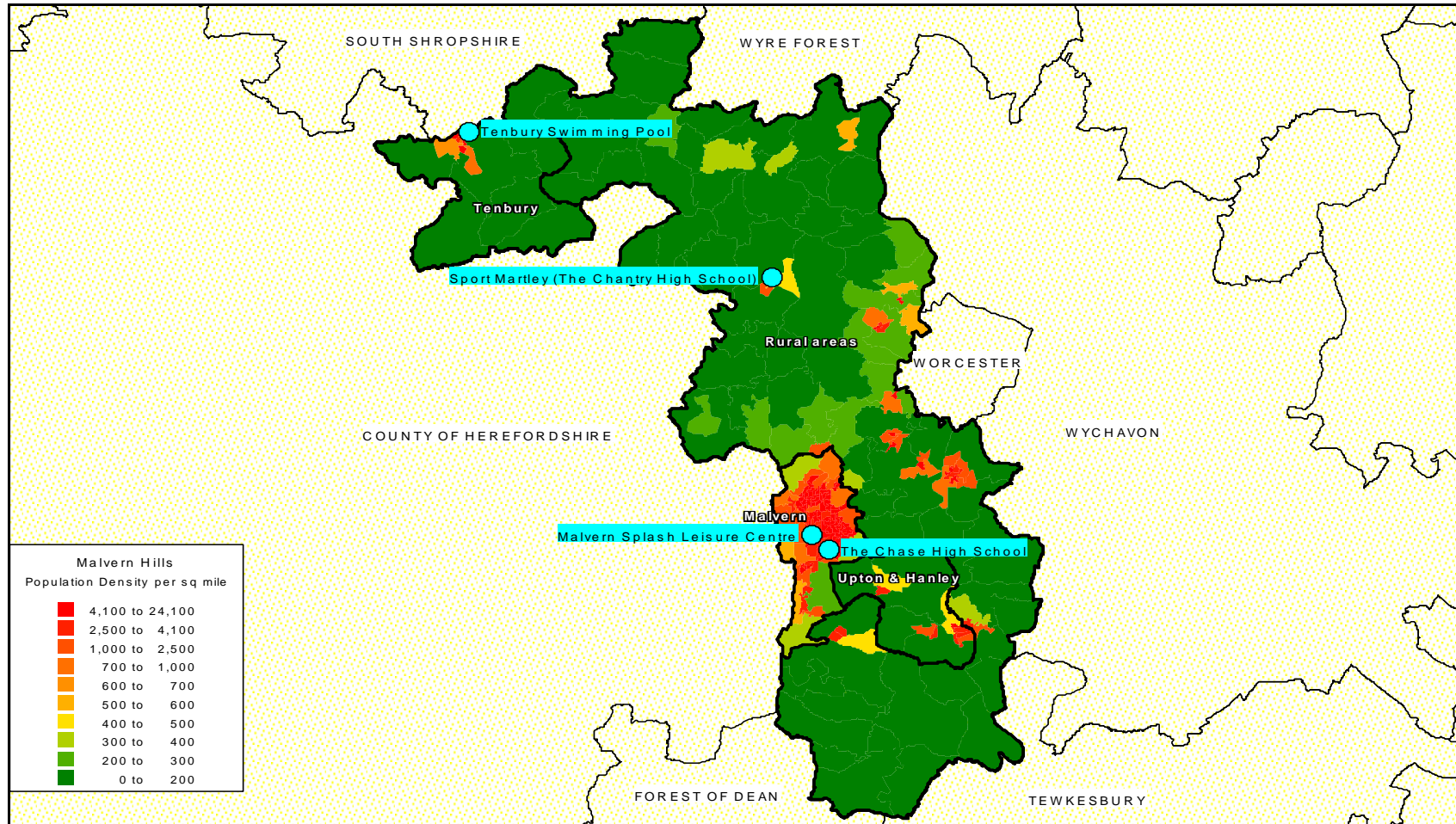


Figure 27.1: Location of fitness facilities in Malvern Hills District
