MALVERN HILLS DISTRICT COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH NO. CM-519 (PART)
CASTLEMORTON) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2018

The above order was made on 25th October 2018. The effect of the order will be to divert that length and the whole width of public footpath no. CM-519, Castlemorton, running from point A, Ordnance Survey "OS" OS grid reference SO 79827 39025, the northern end of footpath CM-519 on the public highway, in a south-south-westerly direction for 144 metres to point B, OS grid reference SO 79795 38884, to a line running from point C, OS grid reference SO 79820 39029, a point on the public highway, in a south-westerly direction for 8 metres to point X, grid reference SO 79814 39024, then continuing in a south-south-westerly direction for 46 metres to point Y, grid reference SO 79804 38980, then continuing in a south-south-westerly direction for 72 metres to point D, grid reference SO 79790 38912, then continuing in south-south-easterly direction for 25 metres to point B, grid reference SO 79795 38884, as shown on the order map.
