

NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER  
TOWN AND COUNTY PLANNING ACT 1990 S.257 AND PARAGRAPH 7 of SCHEDULE 14

MALVERN HILLS DISTRICT COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH NO. KP-509 (PART) KEMPSEY) PUBLIC PATH  
DIVERSION ORDER 2018

On 13<sup>th</sup> February 2019 Malvern Hills District Council confirmed the above order. The effect of the order as confirmed is to divert that length and the whole width of public footpath no. public footpath no. KP-509, Kempsey, running from point A, Ordnance Survey "OS" OS grid reference SO 85108 49932, in an east-north-easterly direction for 32 metres to point B, OS grid reference SO 85139 49940, then continuing in a south-south-easterly direction for 123 metres to point C, OS grid reference SO 85185 49825, to a line running from point A, OS grid reference SO 85108, 49932, in a south-easterly and south-south-easterly direction for 29 metres on a natural/grass surface to point X, OS grid reference SO 85126, 49913, then continuing on a tarmac surface in a south-easterly direction for 36 metres to point D, OS grid reference SO 85141, 49881, then continuing in an east-north-easterly direction on the footway for 6 metres to point E, grid reference SO 85147, 49883, then continuing in a south-south-easterly turning easterly direction on the footway for 80 metres to point C, OS grid reference SO 85185, 49825, as shown on the order map.

This order comes into force on the date on which Malvern Hills District Council certify that the terms of Article 2 of the order have been complied with, but if any person aggrieved by the order desires to question its validity or that of any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the Order, he or she may apply to the High Court for any of these purposes under s.287 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 within 6 weeks from the date on which notice is first published as required by paragraph 7 of Schedule 14 to the Act.
